- **Support for School and Parish Organizations:** The varied groups that meet in the parish will all benefit from having more adequate space to host meetings and events including our growing elementary school.
- **Improved Faith Formation Facilities:** The religious education programs will have better facilities to grow the love of Jesus Christ in all programs.
- **Flexible and Efficient Meeting Space:** This will be useful for future needs or opportunities and will ease scheduling pressures across other parts of the campus.
- **Growth of Early Childhood Development Program:** Increasing the capacity of our current programs which is the pipeline to our school.

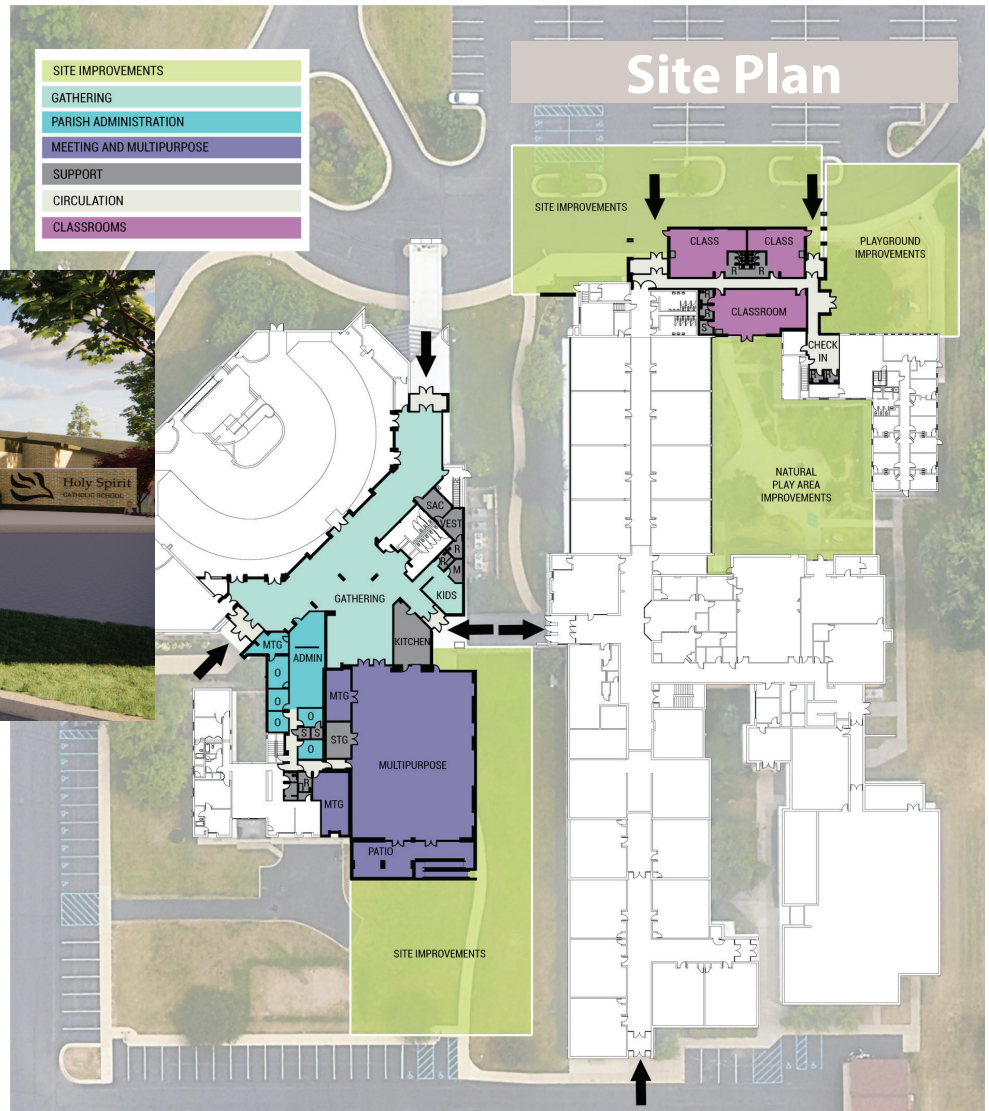
Our VISION

Inspired by the Spirit Project

1. Construction of a 5,500-square-foot parish center addition on the southern side of our current space. This will allow us to renovate 13,000 square feet of existing space, and allocate it for the following:
 - A large multi-purpose space capable of seating up to 350 people.
 - A modest meeting space that can also host music practice and accommodate up to 50 people.
 - An additional meeting space that can accommodate around 50 people, specifically intended for our growing religious education programs, small groups, or general meetings.
 - All of these spaces will be used as flex space should the need arise for school growth or used while other parts of the master plan are being developed.
2. A 2,000 square-foot expansion to our current Child Development Center. This will increase capacity of our early childhood development program as well as increase the safety for drop off and pick up. This expansion will connect the building to the school, enclosing our campus for additional safety.
3. To make way for this expansion, we keep our parish offices in their current location with remodeling to fit the growing needs of our parish. This will be a cost-effective solution and create an attractive work environment for our parish team while maximizing flexibility in implementing the master plan.

Cost

The estimated cost for constructing and renovating the new spaces is expected to be around \$8.3 million.
